
Per our conversation earlier today, I wanted to confirm that BAF has an ownership interest in ServoTech, Inc. ServoTech is one of four firms certified by Ford Motor Company as a “Qualified Calibration Modifier” (QCM), which gives BAF direct access to Ford’s vehicle calibration codes.

What the QCM designation means to BAF is that when we modify the vehicle calibration to work with our proprietary dedicated and bi-fuel CNG upfits, we do so without having to “hack into”, or perform an “unauthorized reflash” of, the vehicle computer, which results in a much more reliable CNG calibration.

BAF is the only company performing CNG upfits on new Ford vehicles that has such a relationship with a QCM that is also a Qualified Vehicle Modifier (QVM) and the holder of a Ford Quality Fleet Care account. The dedication to quality, service and reliability evidenced by these certifications has helped to make BAF America’s leader in CNG conversions.
